

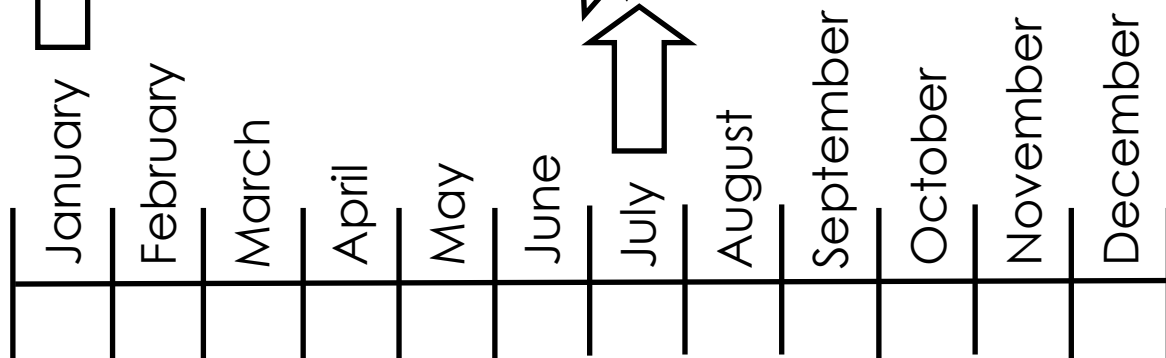
One year has 2 semi-annual sales.

(They could be any two months, half a year apart)

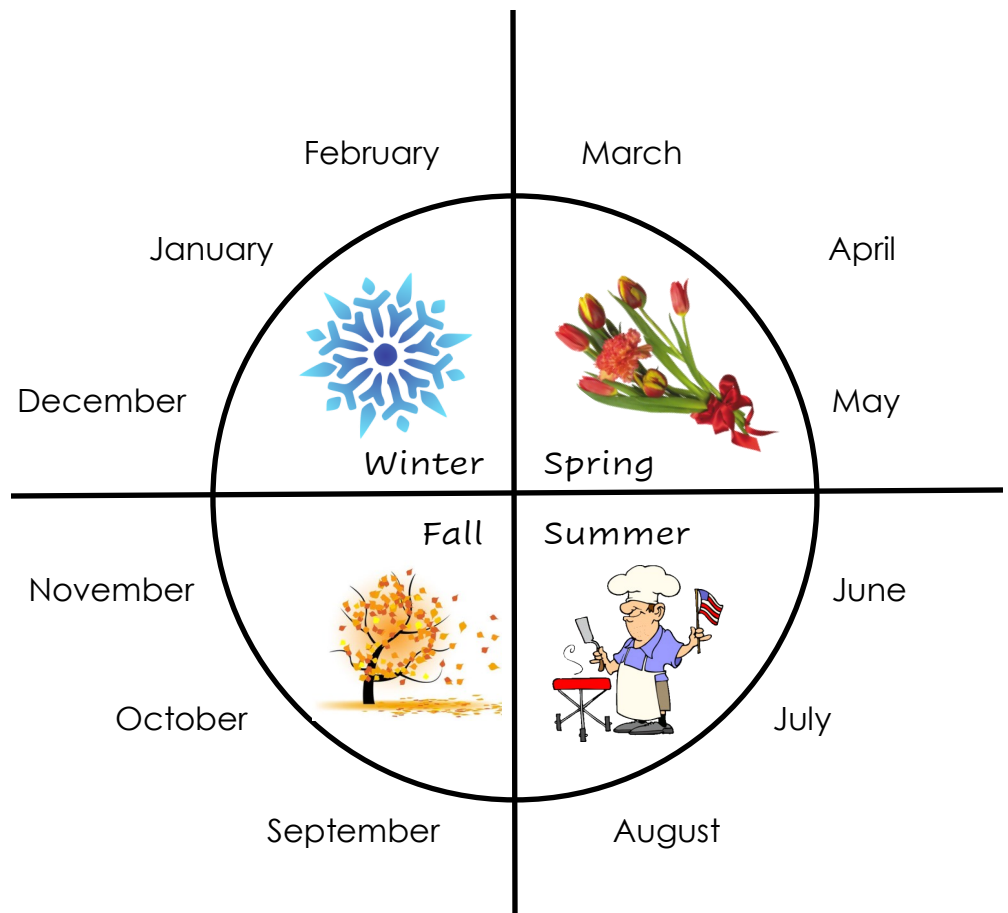
semi = half annual = yearly

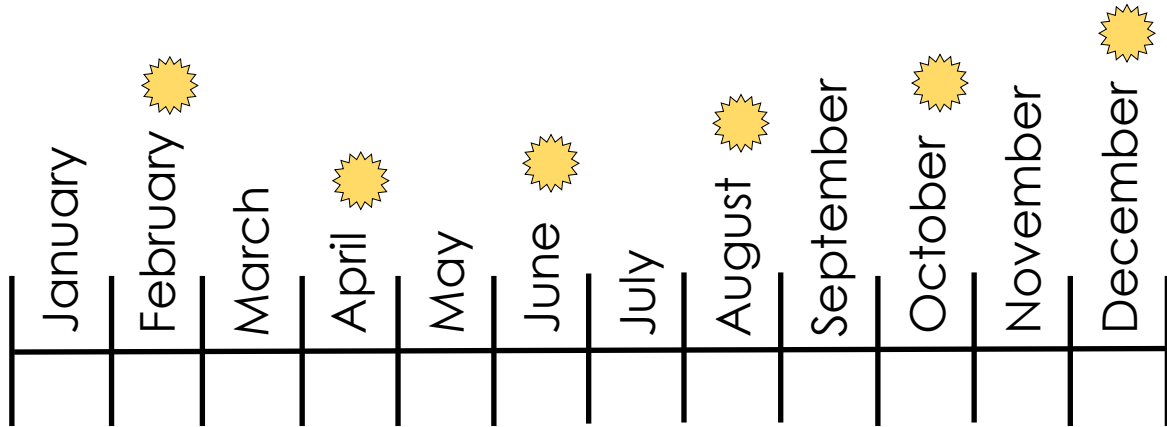

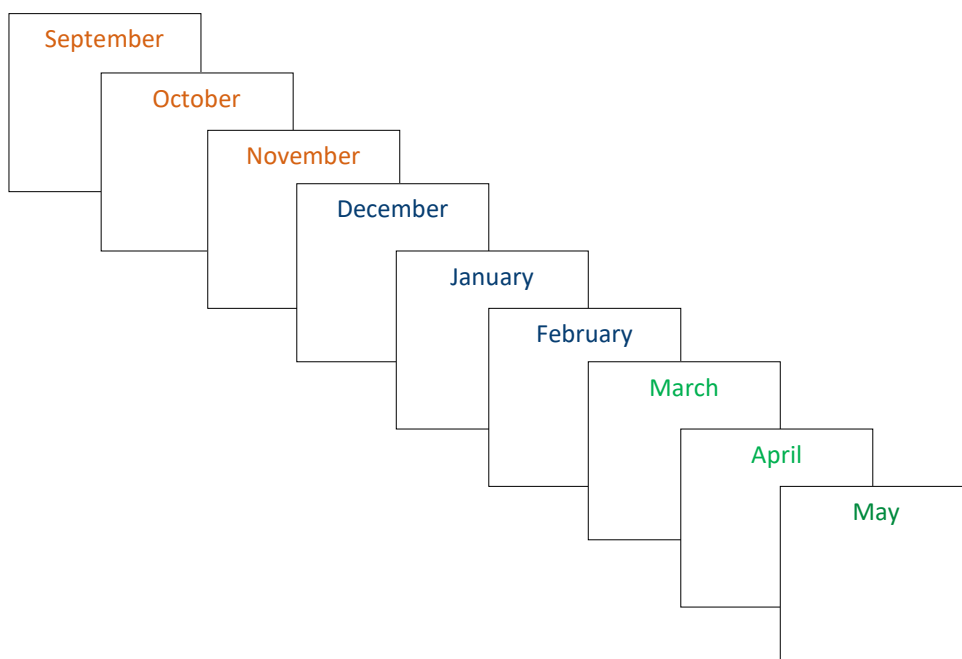

calm ----- breezy

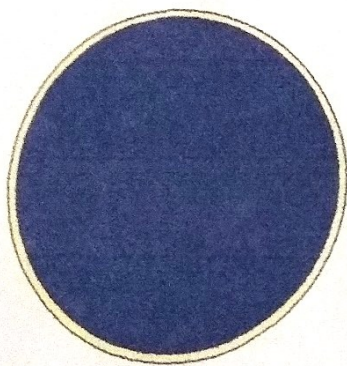

One year has 12 months total (in all).

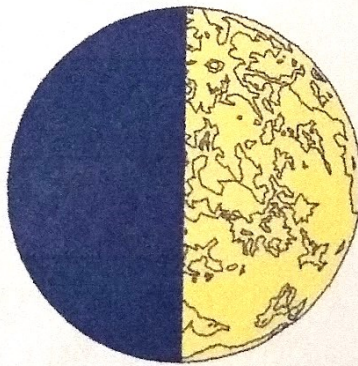

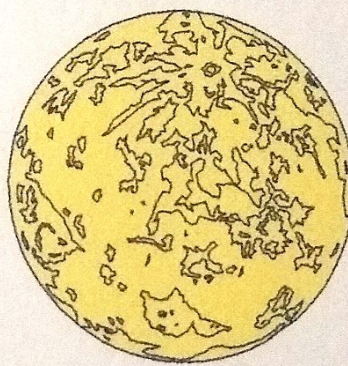

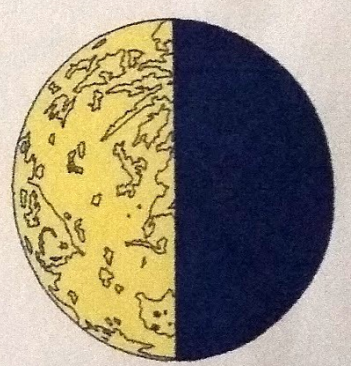
