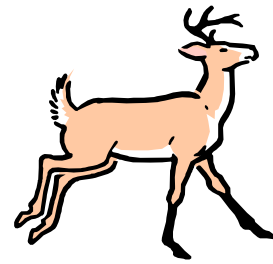

Where do you live, squirrel?



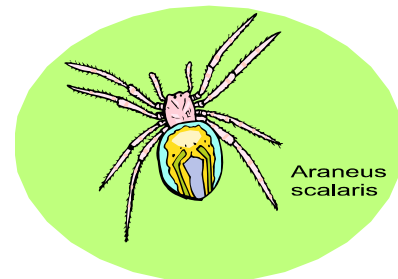
I live in a tree.



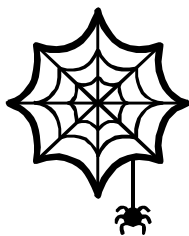
Where do you live, bird?



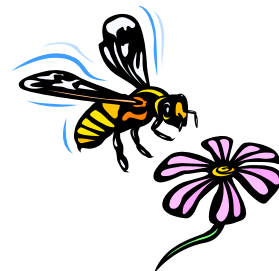
I live in a nest.



Where do you live, spider?



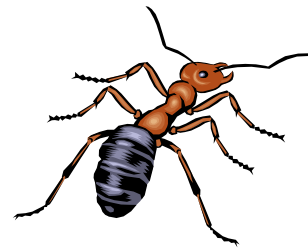
I live in a web.



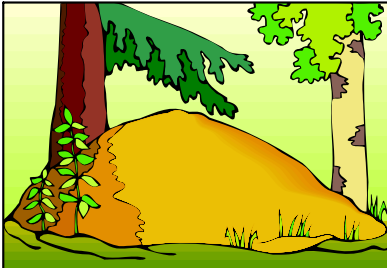
Where do you live, bee?



I live in a hive in a hollow tree.



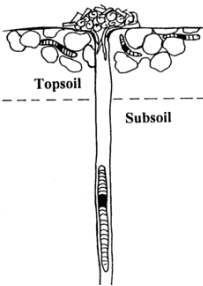
Where do you live, ant?



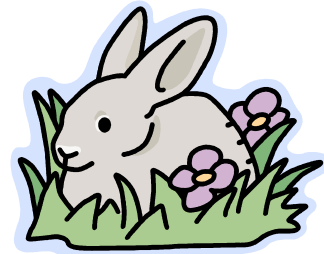
I live in a hill.



Where do you live, worm?



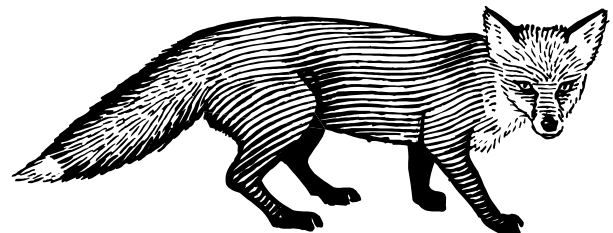
I live in a tunnel underground.



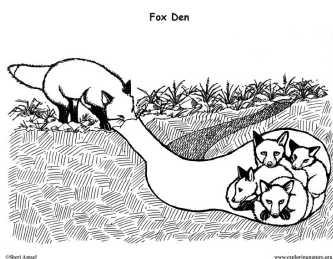
Where do you live, rabbit?



I live in a burrow underground.



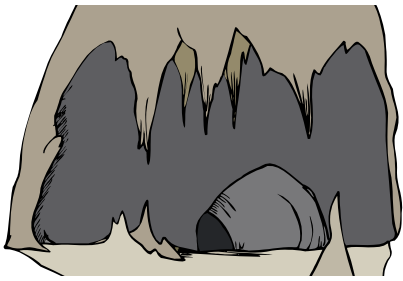
Where do you live, fox?

Where do you live, bat?



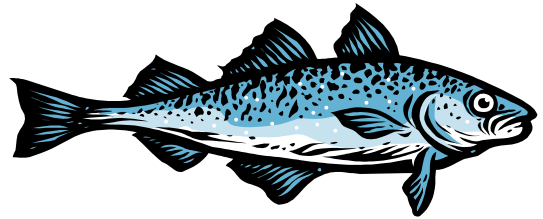
I live in a cave.

I live in a den.



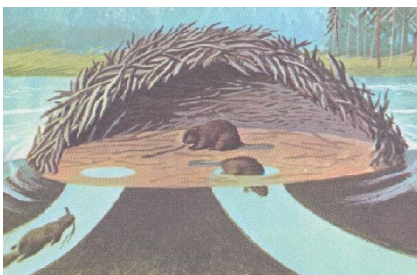
Where do you live, fish?



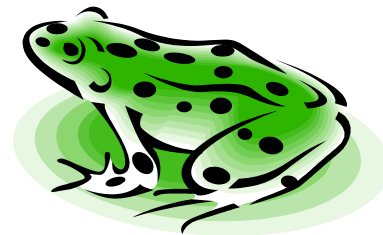
I live in a stream.
