Ready, Set, Go to Church Instructions

1. Front Cover: Letter and draw a simplified picture of your church building
2. Button the shirt: make a doll sized button up shirt with giant buttons (or at least make the front of the shirt). Attach it to the page so that the child can button of 3 or 4 buttons.
3. Zip the pants: make the front of a doll sized pair of zippered pants and attach to the page so that the child can zip the pants. Attach a snap or hook at the top.
4. Buckle the belt: attach some loops to the page to guide the left and right parts of the belt toward the center. Attach a strip of vinyl to the left and right sides of the page, one with a buckle attached, and the other with a soft point and holes for the buckle to buckle to.
5. Tie the shoe: Cut a piece of vinyl in the shape of the shoe top, but cut the tongue separate. The upper part, where the heel would go is "empty" in the center, or you can cut a coordinating color shoe shape for the inside bottom of the shoe. Put the reinforced holes in either side of the shoe top. Attach the tongue behind the front top opening. Attach the shoe top to the page, add a shoe lace.
6. Attach a short strip at the top so that a clip-on tie can be clipped onto it.
7. Comb hair, brush teeth: sew a large clear pocket onto the page, with a pair of Velcro dots at the top to keep things from falling out.
8. Get in the car. You can attach a little pocket "garage" to hold a small car. Draw some shops with streets, signs pointing to the lake and the beach, and a church.
9. Put the pages in pairs, right sides together, and sew around the three sides that will not be in the binding. Clip the corners and turn them right sides out. Attach them together with binding on the left side of the book.

1. Front and back covers.

2. Button & Zip pages.

3. Buckle and Tie pages.

4. Clip tie and comb & brush.
