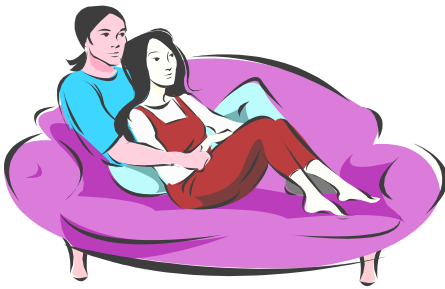
We come in the door.

We hang our coats in the closet.



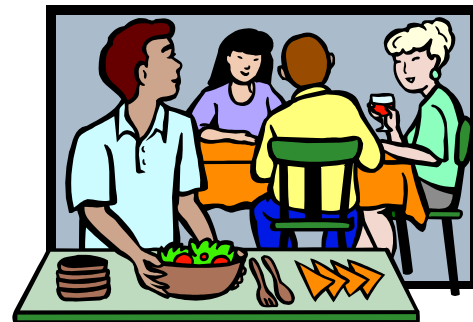
We sit and talk in the living room.



We read and write on the computer in the office.



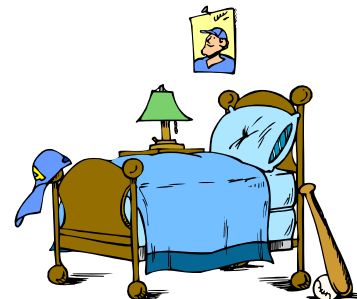
We cook in the kitchen.
