### 1. Singing through the day:

- c. Teacher talks through Teddy getting ready for bed at night/bedtime routine.

### 3. Children can color and cut out Teddy and clothes (Teddy can be boy or girl), and dress Teddy as they like.

### 4. Simon Says dress for . . .

Leader tells the group what Teddy should dress for (weather/season, work/play, special occasion, etc.)

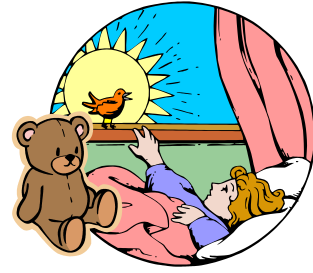
### 5. Lunch or snack

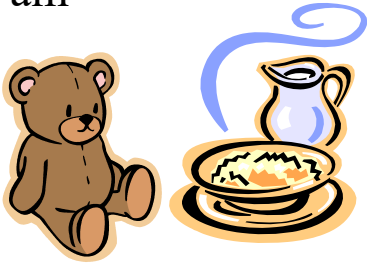

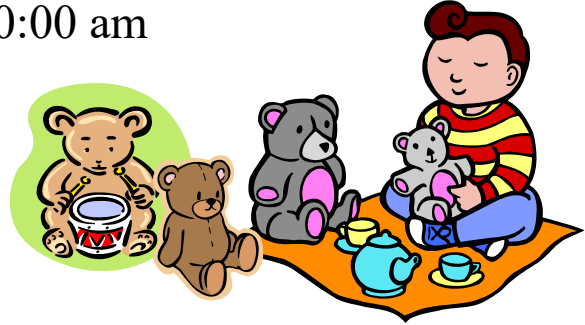
Teddy wakes up. Good Morning.

8:00 am



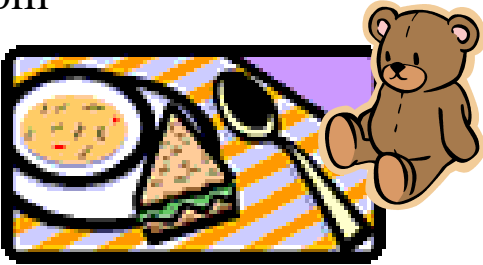
Teddy gets dressed, eats breakfast.

2:00 pm



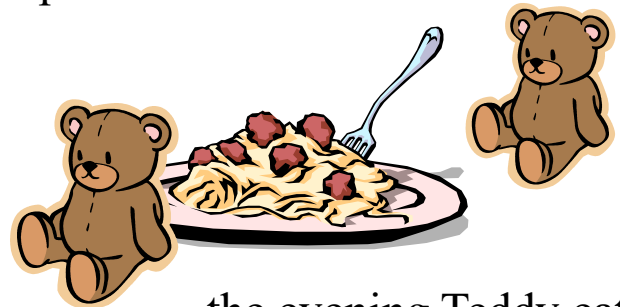
In the afternoon Teddy reads a story.

7:00 pm

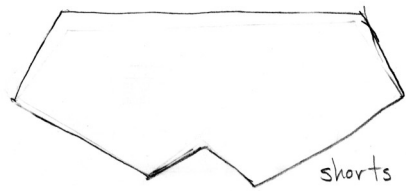


Then Teddy gets ready for bed.

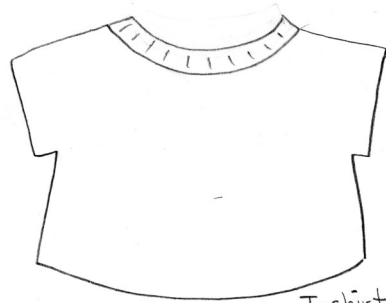
